WHO CAN ENTER

The award is open to all volunteers of ALUCA who must be actively involved and part of an ALUCA committee - this could be part of an ALUCA Sub Group, or ALUCA's Board and Executive Committee, an event committee or other ALUCA volunteer services such as a working group or in Forums. Each entrant for the award must be a current financial member of ALUCA; who has provided a significant contribution of volunteer time and service to ALUCA.

Volunteers of ALUCA can either nominate themselves or another volunteer member. Sub Group Leaders or Board Members can also nominate, self-nominate or be nominated by another volunteer member.

Each ALUCA volunteer group in every state is encouraged to nominate one or more of their amazing volunteers, for their commitment to making an impact on our industry and ALUCA. Members, sponsors and partners alike can also nominate an individual.

HOW TO ENTER

Award entrants must provide responses addressing each of the award criteria and demonstrate excellence as an ALUCA volunteer (max 1,000 words). JUDGING PANEL

KEY AWARD CRITERIA

Judged as going above and beyond their volunteer role requirements with examples that demonstrate this:

- Great customer service - goes out of their way to help and ensure ALUCA members have positive experiences.
- Collegial and builds strong relationships with other ALUCA volunteers, stakeholders and their group/committee with positive communications in and across their ALUCA groups.
- Shows initiative and/ or/ innovation plus drive and results
- Tangible outcomes with examples that support the above

Word limit max 1,000 words + supporting documentation/testimonials

Submission must include ALL of the following:

1. Your summary " Why you/or the nominee deserves the award..." declaration: Max 250 words
2. Address each key criteria point and provide proof to support your points Max 750 words
3. Supporting documentation /Testimonials (limit of 3 testimonials / links)
